

CITY COUNCIL PROCEEDINGS

September 20, 2023

The City Council of the City of David City, Nebraska, met in open public session at 6:00 p.m. to hold a public hearing for the purpose of hearing support, opposition, criticism, suggestions or observations of taxpayers relating to the proposed budget for fiscal year 2023-2024. The meeting was held in the meeting room of the City Office located at 490 "E" Street, David City, Nebraska. The Public had been advised of the meeting by publication of notice in The Banner Press on September 14, 2023, and an affidavit of the publisher is on file in the office of the City Clerk. The Mayor and members of the City Council acknowledged advance notice of the meeting by signing the Agenda which is a part of these minutes. The advance notice to the Public, Mayor, and Council members conveyed the availability of the agenda, which was kept continuously current in the office of the City Clerk and was available for public inspection on the City's website. No new items were added to the agenda during the twenty-four hours immediately prior to the opening of the Council meeting.


The meeting opened with the Pledge of Allegiance.
