

## CITY COUNCIL PROCEEDINGS

September 25, 2024

The City Council of the City of David City, Nebraska, met in open public session at 6:30 p.m. to hold a public hearing for the purpose of hearing support, opposition, criticism, suggestions or observations of taxpayers relating to the proposed budget for fiscal year 2024-2025. The meeting was held in the meeting room of the City Office located at 490 "E" Street, David City, Nebraska. The Public had been advised of the meeting by publication of notice in The Banner Press on September 19, 2024, and an affidavit of the publisher is on file in the office of the City Clerk. The Mayor and members of the City Council acknowledged advance notice of the meeting by signing the Agenda which is a part of these minutes. The advance notice to the Public, Mayor, and Council members conveyed the availability of the agenda, which was kept continuously current in the office of the City Clerk and was available for public inspection on the City's website. No new items were added to the agenda during the twenty-four hours immediately prior to the opening of the Council meeting.

Present for the meeting were: Mayor Jessica Miller, Council members, Pat Meysenburg, Keith Marvin, Bruce Meysenburg, Kevin Woita, Jim Angell, Interim City Administrator/City Clerk Tami Comte, City Administrator Intern Raiko Martinez and City Attorney Michael Sands. Council Member Tom Kobus was absent.

## PER STATE STATUTE 13-506

- This is a comparison between the current budget for 2024-2025 and the prior budget for 2023-2024.
- In 2023-2024 the tax levy was .50 and the tax request was \$1,056,534.56.
- In 2024-2025 the tax levy was .50 and the tax request will be \$1,144,152.40.
